



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ the uses of water
- ▶ the sources of water
- ▶ storing water
- ▶ clean water

### TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, posters, blackboard, pointer, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ The teacher will start the lesson with 'Warm Up'.
- ▶ The teacher, then, will explain the uses of water.
- ▶ The teacher will tell that animals and plants need water.
- ▶ Tell about the sources of water. Ask the students whether they have seen a pond or a river.
- ▶ Show pictures of well, tubewell and handpump.
- ▶ Explain the importance of drinking clean water.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ The teacher may show pictures of polluted rivers and lakes and tell the students to keep the sources of water clean.
- ▶ The teacher may tell the students never to waste water.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to know

- ▶ about the uses of water.
- ▶ the sources of water.
- ▶ the importance of water.

### EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate the students.

1. Why should we save water?
2. Why should we drink water?
