



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn

- ▶ what communication is
- ▶ how messages were sent in the olden times
- ▶ how a letter reaches its destination
- ▶ advantages of cellphones
- ▶ about video calling, Internet, etc.

### TEACHING AIDS

A chart showing different means of communication, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Talk about the gestures used by the dancers to communicate.
- ▶ Tell about the sign language used by the deaf and dumb people.
- ▶ Ask the children if they know how the people in ancient times communicated.
- ▶ Show stamps, postcard, etc., in the class.
- ▶ Tell the students about the Pin Code and its importance.
- ▶ Tell about the journey of a letter.
- ▶ Tell about the advantages and disadvantages of a smartphone.
- ▶ Explain the difference between individual communication and mass communication.
- ▶ Talk about the modern means of communication such as email, WhatsApp, etc.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ Show the chart of different means of communication in the class.
- ▶ You can show an email on the computer in the class.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ different means of communication.
- ▶ advantages of a cellphone.
- ▶ learn the difference between mass communication and individual communication.

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.
