LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- different kinds of plants such as trees, shrubs, herbs, creepers and climbers
- uses of plants

TEACHING AIDS

A chart showing different types of plants, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ The students will love to do the question given in Warm Up.
- ▶ Point out the difference between a tree, shrub and herb.
- ▶ Explain the difference between a creeper and a climber.
- ▶ Talk about the different places such as land and water where plants grow.
- ▶ You can ask the students to name the things we get from plants.
- ▶ Tell how we are dependent on plants.
- Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- Show pictures/animations of the plants.
- ▶ You can talk the students to a garden and show different types of plants.
