Paying for Travel



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will be able to learn about

- ▶ the difference between private means of transport and public means of transport
- the work that a conductor does
- money in the form of coins and notes

TEACHING AIDS

▶ A chart showing different means of transport, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- Ask the students to name the private means of transport and the public means of transport.
- Ask them if they have seen a TTE.
- Show them coins and notes of different values.
- ▶ Tell the students that we can buy a railway/aeroplane ticket on the Internet.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points given under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- Show a railway or aeroplane ticket in the class.
- Show a debit card/credit card to the class.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- private and public means of transport.
- coins and notes of different values.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate the students.

- 1. Why should we use public means of transport more often?
- 2. Why is digital booking of tickets more convenient?
