



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will be able to learn about

- ▶ why animals move in groups
- ▶ how birds help the animals
- ▶ where bees live
- ▶ how honey is made

TEACHING AIDS

- ▶ Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Help the students to do the Warm Up activity.
- ▶ Explain why animals move in groups.
- ▶ Tell the students not to tease or hurt animals.
- ▶ Show the picture of cattle egret, oxpecker and Egyptian plover to the students.
- ▶ Explain how honeybees make honey.
- ▶ Tell the benefits of honey.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the title 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help this students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show pictures/animations of groups of animals.
- ▶ Show picture of a beehive.
