

**LESSON PLAN****SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

- The students will learn about
- ▶ what pottery is
 - ▶ how a potter makes a pot
 - ▶ types of pots
 - ▶ the use of clay in everyday life

TEACHING AIDS

Clay, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Explain the concept of evaporation used in Warm Up.
- ▶ Start by defining what pottery is.
- ▶ Explain through pictures in the book how a potter makes a pot using a potter's wheel.
- ▶ Tell about the different types of pots.
- ▶ Give examples from everyday life to demonstrate the things we use make of clay.
- ▶ You can show pictures of *kulhads*, *gharas*, *diyas*, etc.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show pictures/animations of how a potter makes a pot.
- ▶ You can make things with clay and show it in the class.
- ▶ The students can be taken to a potter's workshop.

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ pot making.
- ▶ different types of pots things made of clay we use.
