

## **LESSON PLAN**

#### **SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES**

The students will learn about

- what pottery is
- how a potter makes a pot
- types of pots
- the use of clay in everyday life

#### **TEACHING AIDS**

Clay, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

#### TEACHING STRATEGY

- Explain the concept of evaporation used in Warm Up.
- Start by defining what pottery is.
- Explain through pictures in the book how a potter makes a pot using a potter's wheel.
- ▶ Tell about the different types of pots.
- Give examples from everyday life to demonstrate the things we use make of clay.
- ▶ You can show pictures of *kulhads*, *gharas*, *diyas*, etc.
- Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

## **BOOST UP**

- ▶ Show pictures/animations of how a potter makes a pot.
- You can make things with clay and show it in the class.
- ▶ The students can be taken to a potter's workshop.

### **EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES**

The students are able to learn about

- pot making.
- different types of pots things made of clay we use.
