



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will be able to learn about

- ▶ terrestrial animals
- ▶ arboreal animals
- ▶ aquatic animals
- ▶ nests made by different birds
- ▶ homes of domestic animals

TEACHING AIDS

A chart showing homes of animals, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Help the students do the Warm Up activity.
- ▶ Give examples of animals living on land, in trees and in water.
- ▶ Explain why birds build nests.
- ▶ Show pictures/animations of nests of birds such as woodpecker, tailor bird, weaver bird.
- ▶ Show pictures/animations of homes of dog, cow, horse, etc.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Take the students for a nature walk and point out the nests of some birds.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ terrestrial animals, arboreal animals and aquatic animals.
- ▶ nests of birds.
- ▶ homes of pets and domestic animals.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate the students.

1. What are arboreal animals?
2. Why is cuckoo considered a very clever bird?
