



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- The students will be able to learn about
- ▶ the invention of the wheel
  - ▶ elephants, horses, yaks, camels as means of transport
  - ▶ care of animals

### TEACHING AIDS

- ▶ Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ After the students have done the Warm Up activity, tell them about the vehicles used in ancient times.
- ▶ Explain how the wheel was invented.
- ▶ Ask the students if they have seen a bullock-cart or tonga.
- ▶ Ask the students if they have seen a bridegroom sitting on a horse in a marriage procession.
- ▶ Tell the students that we should care of the animals and treat them kindly.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ Show a picture/animation of a bridegroom in a procession.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ the invention of the wheel.
- ▶ animals used as means of transport.
- ▶ care of animals.
