Animals for Transport

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will be able to learn about

- the invention of the wheel
- elephants, horses, yaks, camels as means of transport
- care of animals

TEACHING AIDS

▶ Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ After the students have done the Warm Up activity, tell them about the vehicles used in ancient times.
- Explain how the wheel was invented.
- Ask the students if they have seen a bullock-cart or tonga.
- Ask the students if they have seen a bridegroom sitting on a horse in a marriage procession.
- ▶ Tell the students that we should care of the animals and treat them kindly.
- Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

▶ Show a picture/animation of a bridegroom in a procession.
