



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ directions
- ▶ how to find directions
- ▶ location of a place

### TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, a projector, a blackboard, chalk, duster, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ First, the teacher will start with Warm Up.
- ▶ The teacher, then, will teach the students about four main directions.
- ▶ The teacher, then, will teach the students how to find out the directions.
- ▶ Then, the teacher will teach the students about how to find out the location of a place.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ The teacher may use a map.
- ▶ The teacher may show the students a compass.
- ▶ The teacher may take the students to the garden during the sunrise and the sunset to determine directions.
- ▶ The teacher, then, will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- ▶ The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ the directions

- ▶ the location of a place
