

# **LESSON PLAN**

#### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- natural environment and man-made environment
- different types of pollution
- taking care of environment

## TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- The Warm Up activity is related to clean air. The students would love to do this activity.
- Explain the difference between natural environment and man-made environment.
- Explain how selfish human activities have caused pollution.
- With the help of pictures/animations and examples from everyday life, explain the four types of pollution.
- Sensitise the students towards environment and tell about the concept of three R's Reduce, reuse and recycle to save the environment.
- Sum up the chapter by going through the points given under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- Show pictures/animation of different types of pollution
- Ask each student to make a poster on 'Saving Mother Earth'.

- what air, water, land and noise pollution are

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.
