



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ natural environment and man-made environment
- ▶ different types of pollution
- ▶ taking care of environment

### TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ The Warm Up activity is related to clean air. The students would love to do this activity.
- ▶ Explain the difference between natural environment and man-made environment.
- ▶ Explain how selfish human activities have caused pollution.
- ▶ With the help of pictures/animations and examples from everyday life, explain the four types of pollution.
- ▶ Sensitise the students towards environment and tell about the concept of three R's — Reduce, reuse and recycle to save the environment.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points given under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ Show pictures/animation of different types of pollution
- ▶ Ask each student to make a poster on 'Saving Mother Earth'.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ natural and man-made environment
- ▶ what air, water, land and noise pollution are

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.
