



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- The students will learn about
- ▶ the difference between immediate family and extended family
  - ▶ family gatherings
  - ▶ different family traditions
  - ▶ decision-making in a family

### TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Help the students do the Warm Up activity.
- ▶ Explain the concept of extended family.
- ▶ Ask the students how they celebrate events like birthdays, birth of a child, etc., in their families.
- ▶ Ask about the traditions followed in their families.
- ▶ Explain how the family inculcates good values among us.
- ▶ Ask the students who decides important issues in their family?
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ Show pictures/animations of events like birthdays, marriage, etc., been celebrated in a family.
