SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- modern sports
- some famous sportspersons of our country

TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster, digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- Help the students in doing the Warm Up activity.

- Tell the difference between indoor games and outdoor games.
- Ask the students about their favourite games.
