



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn

- ▶ about our five sense organs and their functions
- ▶ what Braille script is
- ▶ what types of ears animals have

TEACHING AIDS

- ▶ blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.
- ▶ objects like pen, pencil, sharpener, stone, wood piece, cotton, spoon, sponge, sandpaper, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Let each student do the Warm Up activity.
- ▶ Tell about the functions of the eyes.
- ▶ Explain what Braille script is.
- ▶ Tell about the functions of the tongue.
- ▶ Tell about the functions of the skin.
- ▶ Tell about the functions of the ears.
- ▶ Explain that we cannot see the ears of some animals.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Ask the students do the Activities given on pages 16, 17 and 18.
- ▶ Show pictures/animations of the Braille script.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ five sense organs.
- ▶ Braille script.
- ▶ ears of animals.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.

1. How can we take care of our eyes?
2. Who was Louis Braille?
3. Which animal has fan-like ears?
