



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

You will learn about

- ▶ types of houses
- ▶ types of roofs
- ▶ qualities of a good house

### TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster, a chart showing different types of houses

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ By doing 'Warm Up' the students will get an idea about the things used to build a house.
- ▶ Tell why we need a shelter.
- ▶ Tell about people who help to build a house.
- ▶ Discuss different kinds of roofs and their utility.
- ▶ Explain building of a house depends upon the following factors: climate, availability of raw materials and budget.
- ▶ Talk about the importance of a clean house.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

### BOOST UP

- ▶ Take the students to a place where a house is being built to let them observe the materials used to build a house.
- ▶ Show animations and chart paper to give an idea of different types of houses.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ *pucca* houses and *kutchha* houses, igloo, caravan, houseboat, stilt house, etc.
- ▶ sloping roof and flat roof.
- ▶ keeping the house clean.

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.

1. Where did early man live?
2. How are houses useful to us?
3. Why should we keep the house clean?
