



Mapping My Neighbourhood

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ the four main directions
- ▶ the importance of a landmark in locating a place
- ▶ top view and side view of an object

TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, compass and digital content

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Talk about the four main directions—North, East, West and South.
- ▶ Ask the students to describe their route from home to school using direction words and important landmarks.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show a map of India and tell about the four directions.
- ▶ Show a compass to the students and explain why it always points to the north.
- ▶ Show a duster and ask the students to draw its top and side view.
- ▶ Talk about the importance of Global Positioning System (GPS) in our lives.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ four main directions
- ▶ how to map a neighbourhood
- ▶ side view and top view of an object

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.

1. Why do people use GPS while driving?
2. How map is useful in locating a place?
3. Why do sailors use a compass?
