

Houses: Changing Times

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- different houses
- different materials used to build a house
- slums

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures of good houses of different designs, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Help the students do the Warm up activity.
- Ask how a house is made and explain them about different types of houses and the type of material used.
- Explain them the difference between a bungalow and a flat.
- Ask the students if they have seen a slum.
- Explain how slums are created.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points given under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- Show pictures of different types of houses.
- Ask students to collect samples of different building materials.
- ▶ The students may be encouraged to paste the pictures of their houses in their notebooks and write five lines on why they like their houses.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- housing.
- different types of building materials.

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their understanding.
