

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- social insects like ants and honeybees
- animals moving in groups

TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- Help the students do the Warm Up activity.
- Explain what social insects are.
- Describe in detail the life of ants.
- Tell about the functions of the queen ant, male ants and worker ants.
- Tell about the life of honeybees.
- Explain why some animals like elephants, lions, etc., live in groups.

BOOST UP

• Ask the students to draw a beehive.
