Clean Work — Dirty Work



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- different people who help us
- dignity of labour

TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- The picture in the Warm Up activity shows different occupations.
- ▶ The students would gain a lot of information by doing this activity.
- Ask the students one by one to tell what a driver, maid, gardener, etc., does.
- ▶ Explain the fact that our life cannot go on without the services offered by sweeper, maid, etc.
- ▶ Tell the students to respect everyone, irrespective of their occupation.
- Narrate an anecdote/incident from the life of Mahatma Gandhi that shows he never considered any work inferior.
- Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show picture/animation of Mahatma Gandhi weaving on a spinning wheel.
- Ask the students what they would like to do on growing up.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.
