LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- what qualities make a person unique
- which factors influence our likes and dislikes
- what Braille script is
- about Helen Keller and the sign language

TEACHING AIDS

A chart of Braille script, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ The students will enjoy doing the Warm Up activity.
- ▶ Talk about the unique qualities of family members of the students.
- ▶ Tell the students to appreciate the unique qualities of other persons.
- Point out the factors that influence our likes and dislikes.
- ▶ Narrate the extract from the autobiography of Helen Keller.
- Show the chart of the sign language.

BOOST UP

- Ask each student to narrate his/her unique quality.
- If possible, take the students to a blind school.
