



Plants from Other Countries

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ how tea is grown
- ▶ origins of some fruits, vegetables, trees, spices and flowers

TEACHING AIDS

Blackboard chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ The students may have trouble in writing the English names of spices, so help them.
- ▶ Explain how tea is grown. Tell about the parts of India where tea is grown.
- ▶ Tell about the countries from where some fruits, vegetables, trees, flowers and spices originated.
- ▶ You can read from the tables given on pages 108 and 109 of the book.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ You can show pictures/animations of tea gardens of Darjiling.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES
