



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- The students will learn about
- ▶ uses of animals
 - ▶ people who depend on animals

TEACHING AIDS

A chart showing products we get from animals, blackboard, chalk and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ When the students have done the Warm Up activity, ask them for some more products we get from animals.
- ▶ Show the chart of animal products to the students.
- ▶ Tell the students that animals like rabbits, guineapigs, etc., are used for testing new medicines.
- ▶ Tell how monkey charmers and snake charmers depend on animals for their livelihood. Also, mention about animals in a circus who entertain us.
- ▶ Tell the students that we should love and take care of animals.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show pictures/animations of a circus show.
