

When People Do Not Get Food



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ that famines are caused by natural calamities and man-made phenomena
- ▶ deficiency diseases

TEACHING AIDS

A chart showing deficiency diseases, blackboard, chalk, duster and digital content.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ Help the students do the 'Warm up' activity.
- ▶ Explain that natural calamities like earthquakes, floods, etc., cause a lot of damage to crops, cattle and human life.
- ▶ Explain that improper food storage, blackmarketing, hoarding and poverty are man-made phenomena responsible for famines.
- ▶ Explain that deficiency diseases are caused due to lack of nutrients like vitamins, fats, carbohydrates, minerals and water in our diet.
- ▶ Sum up the chapter by going through the points under the head 'Remember'.
- ▶ Finally, help the students do all the exercises.

BOOST UP

- ▶ Show the chart containing deficiency diseases.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn about

- ▶ causes of famines.
- ▶ deficiency diseases.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teachers may ask the following questions to evaluate their students.

2. What is rickets?
