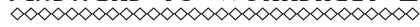


- A. 1. Government is a political system by which society is governed. It makes decisions and laws to govern the people and ensure their welfare.
2. The executive is one of the organs of government which implements its laws.
3. Parliamentary government is seen in two forms—either with a union of powers when the executive derives its powers from the legislature or by a separation of powers as in a presidential form.
4. Franchise refers to election or the right to vote.
5. The judiciary is the organ of government that ensures that the laws are followed by the government and the people.
