

# Fun at the Park

# LESSON PLAN

# SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- · Learning that recreation is as important as studying
- Playing keeps us healthy and fit
- Recognising things in a park
- Vocabulary—Words, meanings, spellings, pronunciation
- Grammar—Verbs and their usage
- Learning to converse

#### WARM UP

- Ask the students the games they like to play.
- Talk to them about the benefits of playing outdoors.

**Outcome:** Playing in a park is a good form of recreation.

#### READ AND ENJOY

- Read aloud the lesson and ask the students to read in turns.
- Correct their pronunciation.
- Explain the lesson.

**Outcome:** Reading aloud, listening attentively, learning new words, spellings, pronunciation.

#### READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Exercise A: Discuss each question with options. Let the students mark the correct options in the book.
- Let the students do Exercises B and C on their own in the class. Correct them if they are wrong.

**Outcome:** Understanding and answering the questions.

## GRAMMAR IS FUN

- Explain what verbs are using the blackboard and examples from classroom, school and home.
- Exercises D and E can be done orally in the class. The students can write answers in their notebooks.

**Outcome:** Learning about verbs and their usage.

#### SPELL WELL

• Ask students to select word from the given box and fill in the blanks with letters.

Outcome: Recalling words in the lesson, learning to spell.

#### WORD POWER

• Explain what opposite words are. Encourage the students to find the opposites.

Outcome: Learning opposites.

#### LET'S LISTEN

• Ask the students to listen to the passage carefully. Ask questions one at a time and ask the students to answer them orally.

Outcome: Listening attentively, understanding and answering the questions orally.

#### SPEAK WELL

• Read the given words aloud, carefully differentiating the sound |x| and |z|

**Outcome:** Learning the difference in pronouncing |x| and |z|

#### CONVERSE AND CONNECT

- Let two students enact the conversation. Correct their pronunciation.
- · Correct the pronunciation, pauses, inflexions, etc.

Outcome: Learning how to talk, pronounce, pause, etc.

#### SPEAK AND EXPRESS

• The students will share the games they play in a park.

**Outcome:** Enhancement of self-confidence and speaking skills.

### WRITE WELL

• Discuss the possible words that can be added to complete each sentence.

**Outcome:** Using suitable words to make complete sentences.

## ACTIVIT V/PROJECT

• Encourage the students to do colouring without anybody's help.

**Outcome:** Expressing individual creativity.
