ANSWERS TO WORKSHEET I



- A. 1. It was fought in 1192 and in it Prithviraj Chauhan was defeated by Muhammad Ghori, marking the beginning of Turk-Afghan rule in India.
2. He was the first Mamluk or Slave dynasty ruler and he built the Qutub Minar.
3. He was known for his efficient administration and he introduced silver and copper coins.
4. It was a tax levied on non-Muslims for providing state protection, first introduced by Feroz Shah Tughlaq.
5. This was the system of recording the identities of soldiers introduced by Alauddin Khalji.
6. This was the name given to Devagiri when Mohammad-bin-Tughlaq tried unsuccessfully to shift his capital there.
7. This was the capital of the Vijayanagar Empire.
8. This was the capital of the Bahamani kingdom.
9. This was the name of the provinces of the kingdom begun by Iltumish and later continued by Ibrahim Lodhi.
10. Villages were clubbed together into Parganas under the charge of a Headman or Muqqaddam by Ibrahim Lodhi.
