SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- what manufacturing is
- what industry is
- cottage industry, small-scale industry and large-scale industry
- industrial belts

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, a projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- Start with Warm Up.
- Tell what manufacturing is.
- Tell what an industry is.
- Tell about cottage industry, small-scale industry and large-scale industry.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may show charts.
- The teacher may show thematic maps of India.
- The teacher may show different mineral ores.
- Then, the teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises. Guide them wherever required.
- Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.
