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LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- national festivals
- religious festivals
- harvest festivals
- birthday celebrations of famous persons

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will start with Warm Up. It will give an insight into the lesson.
- Tell about different types of festivals.
- Tell about national festivals in detail.
- Tell about religious festivals in detail.
- Tell about harvest festivals in detail.
- Tell about birthday celebrations.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may show chart paper to show different celebrations.
- The teacher may show flashcards for different festivals.
- The teacher may show video clippings from TV channels regarding national and religious festival celebrations in different parts of the country.
- Ask the students to solve the exercises.
- Initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.
