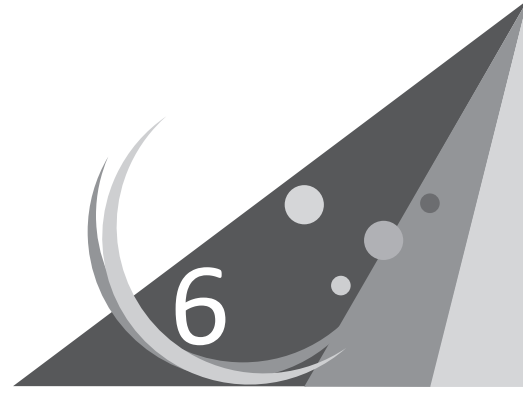


The Land of Ice and Snow (Greenland)



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- Greenland
- the location and extent of Greenland
- the physical features of Greenland
- the climatic conditions of Greenland
- the natural vegetation and wildlife of Greenland
- the people living in Greenland

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, a projector, models, flashcards, globes, maps, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, start with Warm Up.
- Tell about Greenland.
- Tell about the location and extent of Greenland.
- Tell about the physical features of Greenland.
- Tell about the climatic conditions of Greenland.
- Tell about vegetation and wildlife of Greenland.
- Tell about the people living in Greenland.

BOOST UP

- To make the lesson interesting, the teacher may show chart papers.
- To make the lesson interesting, the teacher may show photographs.
- To make the lesson interesting, the teacher may show video clippings.
- Then, the teacher will ask to solve the exercise given in the lesson.
- Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion the topic given in Think and Answer.
- Then, the teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Value Corner.
