LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- products we get from animals
- animals which help us carry loads

TEACHING AIDS

Chart, blackboard, chalk, duster, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will ask the students to tick (✓) the things we get from animals given in Warm Up.
- Then, the teacher will tell the uses of animals. He/She can cite examples from everyday life to make the students aware about the things we get from animals.
- Tell about ox, which is used to plough fields.
- Tell about donkey, camel and elephant which are used to carry loads.

BOOST UP

- Show a chart depicting things we get from animals.
- Ask the students to name cartoon characters which entertain us.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn

- the uses of animals.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate his/her students.

1. Why is camel so useful in deserts?
2. How do honeybees make honey?
