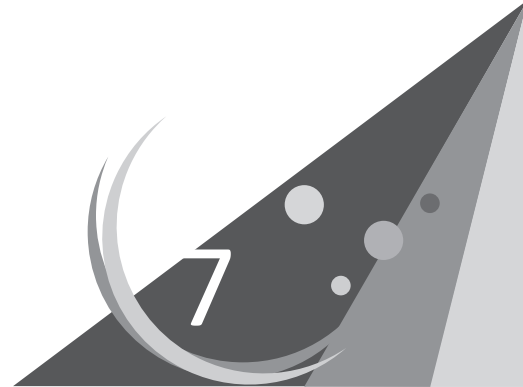


# India—The National Symbols



## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about our National

- Flag
- Emblem
- Anthem, song
- Animal, bird, flower, etc.

### TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, a projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- Start with Warm Up.
- Tell about our National Flag. Explain the meaning of the colours in the flag.
- Tell about our National Emblem.
- Tell about our National Anthem.
- Tell about our National Song.
- Tell about our National Animal, National Bird, etc.

### BOOST UP

- The teacher may show chart papers.
- The teacher may show flashcards.
- The teacher may ask the students to sing the National Anthem.
- The teacher may ask the students to sing the National Song.
- The teacher will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.

### EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students should have knowledge about the

- National Anthem
- National Song
- National Animal, Bird, etc.
