



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- uses of water
- storing water
- sources of water
- clean water

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, posters, blackboard, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- The teacher will start the lesson with 'Warm Up'.
- The teacher, then, will explain what uses of water.
- The teacher tell the animals and plants to need water.
- Tell about sources of water. Ask the students whether they have seen a pond or river.
- Show pictures of well, tubewell and handpump.
- Explain the importance of drinking clean water.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may show pictures of polluted rivers and lakes and tell the students to keep the sources of water clean.
- The teacher may tell the students never to waste water.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to know

- about the uses of water.
- the sources of water.
- importance of water.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate the students.

1. Why should we save water?
2. Why should we drink water?
