
Water for All



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- sources of water
- uses of water
- clean water

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, a projector, a blackboard, chalk, duster, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY
