

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students learn about

- the different types of school
- the places in our school
- the celebrations in the school

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, models, photographs, a blackboard, duster, chalk, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will ask the students to tick the correct picture given in Warm Up. The teacher should explain the meaning of the pictures.
- The teacher may give a brief lecture on the necessity of going to school.
- Then, the teacher will tell about different types of schools. The teacher may show pictures of the school with the students. This will help the students understand the differences among schools.
- The teacher, then, will tell about the rooms in a school. He/She may take the students to different rooms and may introduce the things kept there.
- Then, the teacher will tell about different festivals celebrated in the school. He/She should explain the importance of the days. He/She may advise the students to take part in the celebrations.

BOOST UP

- To make the lesson interesting and to encourage the students to take part in school activities, the teacher may show photographs of students who took part in previous celebrations.
- The teacher may show video clippings of the celebrations held in the school.
- The teacher, then, will ask the students to solve the exercises given in the lesson.
- The teacher should initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn

• the things they learn in the school

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- the different types of schools
- the different places in a school including their activities
- the festivals celebrated in the school
