LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students learn about

- directions
- how to find directions
- location of a place

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, a projector, a blackboard, chalk, duster, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will start with Warm Up.
- The teacher, then, will teach the students about four main directions.
- The teacher, then, will teach the students how to find out the directions.
- Then, the teacher will teach the students about how to find out the location of a place.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may use a map.
- The teacher may show the students a compass.
- The teacher may take the students to the garden during the sunrise and the sunset to determine directions.
- The teacher, then, will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- The teacher will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.
