LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- Reading, enjoying and reciting poetry.
- Understanding the poem.
- Answering questions on the poem.

READING

- Read the poem aloud with correct pronunciation and rhythm.
- Ask the students to learn and recite the poem.
- Correct their pronunciation, etc.

Outcome: Read, recite, understand and enjoy the poem.

READ AND UNDERSTAND

- Ask the students to do Exercise A on their own.
- Exercises B and C can be discussed.
- Then students can answer on their own.
- Announce the correct answers and the students can check their answers.

Outcome: Answering the questions orally and in writing.
