

## LESSON PLAN

### SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- what transport is
- need of transport
- land transport
- water transport
- air transport
- some rules of road safety

### TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

### TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will ask the students to solve the exercise given in Warm Up.
- Tell what transport is.
- Tell about the need of transport.
- Tell about land, water and air transport.
- In the last, tell about road safety rules.

### BOOST UP

- The teacher may show chart papers.
