

Likes, Dislikes and Hobbies

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- their likes and dislikes
- their hobbies

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper having pictures of different games, cartoons, food items, coins, stamps, books, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will ask the students questions related to their interest in games, cartoons and food items. Then, he/she should ask the questions given in the 'Warm Up'.
- The teacher, then, can explain features of some games likes football, cricket and hockey.
- The teacher can tell difference between indoor and outdoor games.
- The teacher can ask the students to draw pictures of their likes and dislikes and colour them appropriately.
- The teacher can explain about eating food.
- The students may be asked to indicate their habits.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may ask the students to think about good habits.
- The teacher may explain the importance of having balance between time devoted to study and habits.
- Lastly, students may be given examples of likes, dislikes and hobbies, etc.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to

- tell their likes
- express their dislikes
- indicate their hobbies

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions for evaluating students' understanding.

- 1. Why do you like different activities?
- 2. When do you start disliking things?
- 3. What are the advantages of hobbies?
- 4. Which activities may help you in better understanding?
