LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- time
- days, months and years

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper, a projector, a blackboard, chalk, duster, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will start with the rhyme given in Warm Up.
- Then, the teacher, with the help of a clock, introduce the hands of the clock.
- Then, he/she will tell about seconds, minute and hour.
- Then, the teacher will tell about the different times of the day.
- The teacher, then, will tell about days, months and years.

BOOST UP

- The teacher should take a clock while discussing the matter.
- The teacher, then, will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- The teacher, will initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students will be able to learn about

- time, i.e. to calculate time
- days, months and years
