LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about Kolkata in detail.

TEACHING AIDS

• Chart papers, flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- First, the teacher will ask the name of the vehicle whose picture is given in Warm Up.
- Tell about Kolkata's location and its climate.
- Tell about Kolkata Municipal Corporation.
- In the last, tell about festivals celebrated in Kolkata. Lay particular emphasis on Durga Puja.

BOOST UP

- The teacher may use a political map of Kolkata to show different locations.
- The teacher may use flashcards to show pictures of different monuments in Kolkata.
- The teacher may show a slide show on Durga Puja held in Kolkata.
- The teacher, then, will ask the students to solve the exercises.
- Initiate a discussion on the topic given in Think and Answer.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES
