LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students learn about

- what communication is
- personal communication
- mass communication

TEACHING AIDS

Chart papers, flashcards, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY
