LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- The students learn about
- ▶ the house, i.e., what a house is
 - ▶ the need for a house
 - ▶ the different types of a house
 - ▶ the types of roofs of a house

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper containing pictures of different types of houses, models of houses, flashcards, a projector, a blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ First, the teacher will ask the students to solve the exercise given in Warm Up. It is very important for the students to learn their addresses.
- ▶ Then, the teacher will tell about the need of a house for us.
- ▶ The teacher, then, will tell about different types of houses. He/She also tell the students that there are different types of *pucca* houses and *kutchra* houses.

BOOST UP

- ▶ To make the lesson interesting, the teacher may use models of different houses.
- ▶ The teacher may tell the students that temporary houses are built for temporary uses.
- ▶ The teacher should advise the students to keep their house neat and clean.
- ▶ The teacher should initiate a discussion on the topic given in Life Skills.
- ▶ The teacher should ask the students to solve the exercises.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn

- ▶ what a house is
- ▶ the need of a house
- ▶ different types of houses
- ▶ the roofs of a house

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate his/her students.

1. Why do we need a house?
2. What types of houses are there?
3. What is an igloo?
4. Where do we see a stilt house?
5. Where do we see a house with the sloping roof?
