



8 Heidi and the Kittens

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

- › Learning that a child views the world from a different perspective.
- › Listening, reading and understanding the lesson.
- › Answering questions orally and in writing.
- › Vocabulary–Words, meanings, spellings, jumbled words
- › Grammar–Use of prepositions
- › Learning to converse

Warm Up

- * Let us students do the maze activity in Warm Up.
- * Ask the difference between cities and towns.

Outcome: Enhancement of creativity.

Read and Enjoy

- * Ask the students to read aloud the lesson in turns.
- * Correct their pronunciation.
- * Explain the lesson.
- * Ask questions like: Do you like green surroundings? Do you like cats or dogs more?

Outcome: Read aloud, listen and understand words, meanings, spellings and pronunciation.

Read and Understand

- * Let the students do Exercises A and B on their own. Announce the correct answers and the students can check their answers.
- * Discuss Exercise C and D. Write the correct answers on the blackboard after discussion. The students can transcribe their answers in their notebooks.

Outcome: Reading and understanding, and answering questions orally and in writing.

Grammar is Fun

- * Using the blackboard and given examples explain prepositions.
- * Discuss Exercises E and F. Then, the students can do on their own. Announce the correct answers aloud and the students can correct them in pairs.

Outcome: Kinds of prepositions and their usage.

Word Power

- * Let the students do Exercise G on their own.
- * Announce the correct answers and the students can check their answers.

Outcome: Learning how to unjumble words.

Let's Listen

- * Read the passage and the poem.
- * Ask questions one by one.

Outcome: Listening attentively, understanding and answering questions.

Let's Converse

- * Let two students enact the roles of Vani and Priya.
- * Let them enact the dialogues in the class.
- * The rest of the class can comment on the dialogue enactment, pronunciation, expression, etc.

Outcome: Learning speech, rhythms and pronunciation.

Let's Speak

- * Pronounce the words. Let the students follow.
- * Correct their pronunciation.

Outcome: Pronouncing words in the correct way.

Writing Skills

- * Let the students write the diary entry. Assess them and make corrections.

Outcome: Enhancement of writing skills.

Activity

- * Let the students colour the cat in colours of their own choice.

Outcome: Expressing one's creativity.
