



LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ▶ a good house
- ▶ methods to keep houses clean
- ▶ qualities of a good house

TEACHING AIDS

A chart paper containing pictures of a clean house, an unclean house, cleaning things, flashcards, projector, blackboard, chalk, duster, pointer, etc.

TEACHING STRATEGY

- ▶ First, the teacher will ask the students to complete the exercise in 'Warm Up'.
- ▶ The teacher will define a clean house and its qualities.
- ▶ The teacher will describe steps to keep the house clean.
- ▶ The teacher will tell features of a good house.

BOOST UP

- ▶ The teacher will ask students to list difference between a clean and an unclean house.
- ▶ The teacher will ask students to explore steps to make house clean.
- ▶ The teacher will show pictures of things required to keep a house clean.
- ▶ The students should be asked to describe a good house.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students are able to learn

- ▶ about a clean house
- ▶ different steps to clean houses
- ▶ about things required to keep a house clean
- ▶ about a good house and how to decorate it.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

The teacher may ask the following questions to evaluate his/her students.

1. What is a clean house?
2. Which things and animals make a house dirty?
3. What are the steps to keep a house clean?
4. What is a good house?
5. Why do we decorate a house?
