LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ♦ What is weather
- ♦ Different days

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures/charts/models/animations on sunny day; cold day; windy day; rainy day; rainy season, summer season, spring season, winter season and autumn season (all as given in chapter)

LESSON PLAN

- ♦ Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section by discussing clouds and their impact on the weather.
- ♦ Now, teacher will explain the meaning of weather, its features and types.
- ♦ With the help of teaching aids, teacher will explain the types of weather and their features (as given in chapter).
- ♦ Teacher will also discuss the impact of each type of weather on people's lifestyle.
- ♦ Now, to evaluate the understanding of students, teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point 1'.
- ♦ Now, teacher will define season and its types.
- ♦ With the help of teaching aids, teacher will discuss the features of each type of weather.
- ♦ Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 2'.
- ♦ At last, teacher will sum up the lesson by going through the points given under the head 'Wrap up now'.
- ♦ Teacher will help students to answer the questions given under the head 'Practice Time'.

BOOST UP

♦ Teacher can encourage students to give their own views for each type of weather and each season.

- ♦ Teacher should encourage students to tell some features of their favourite season.
- ♦ Teacher should encourage students to draw pictures of their favourite weather and favourite season.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students understand and know

- the weather and its four types.
- ♦ features of four types of weather.
- ♦ season, its four types and their features.
