LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- types, parts and structure of a tooth
- need and care of teeth and gums
- role of food in the development of healthy teeth and gums

Teaching Aids

Pictures/charts/models/animation on the topics given in the chapter.

Lesson Plan

- Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section discussing the healthy and unhealthy food items.
- Teacher will explain the importance of teeth.
- With the help of suitable teaching aid, teacher will explain the types of teeth and the two sets of teeth.
- To check the understanding of students about the topic, teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point 1'.
- Now, teacher will explain parts and structure of a tooth.
- Teacher will discuss taking care of teeth and gums.
- Teacher will discuss food good for maintaining healthy teeth and gums.
- Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 2'.
- At last, teacher will sum up the chapter by going through all the points given under the head 'Wrap up now' and revising the 'New Words'.
- Finally, teacher will help students to solve all the exercises given under the head 'Practice Time'.

Boost Up

- Teacher should demonstrate activities given in the chapter.
- Teacher should encourage students to eat food which is good for healthy teeth and gums.
- Teacher should encourage students for taking dental care and keeping oral hygiene.
