Parts of a Plant

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ⇒ parts of a plant
- ♦ how plants grow

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures/charts/models/animations on a complete plant; leaves of different plants, flowers; fruits with one seed, few seeds and many seeds; a germinating seed

LESSON PLAN

- ♦ Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section by asking some general questions on plant parts.
- ♦ With the help of teaching aids, teacher will explain the different parts of plants and their functions.
- ♦ Now, teacher will explain how plants grow from seeds.
- ♦ Teacher will also tell how a seed germinates.
- ♦ Now, to check the understanding of students, the teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point'.
- At last, teacher will sum up the lesson by going through the points given under the head 'Wrap up now'.
- ♦ Teacher will help students to answer the questions given under the head 'Practice Time'.

BOOST UP

Teacher can show the specimens of a complete plant, leaves, flowers and fruits of different types and germinating seeds.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students know

- the parts of plants and their functions.
- types of leaves based on size.

- types of fruits based on number of seeds.
- ♦ how plants grow from seeds.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

Teacher may ask the following questions for evaluating learning and understanding of students:

- 1. What does a stem bear?
- **2.** Which part of a plant is colourful?
- **3.** What does a seed have inside it?
- 4. Which part of plant has seeds inside it?
