Animals Around Us

LESSON PLAN

SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES

The students will learn about

- ✧ types of animals
- ✧ animal homes
- ✧ animal babies

TEACHING AIDS

Pictures/charts/models/animations on big animals; small animals; wild animals; domestic animals; pet animals; living places of animals; babies of animals; animals feeding their young ones (all as given in chapter)

LESSON PLAN

- ✧ Teacher will start the chapter with 'Gear Up' section by giving the idea that animals are important part of our life.
- ✧ With the help of teaching aids, teacher will explain the types of animals (as given in chapter – based on size and living place).
- ✧ Teacher will explain by giving examples that some animals are useful to us and therefore, we keep them with us.
- ✧ Now, to evaluate the understanding of students, teacher will ask them to solve 'Check Point 1'.
- ✧ Now, with the help of teaching aids, teacher will describe the living places of different wild animals (as given in chapter).
- ✧ Then, teacher will tell the names of some animal babies (as given in chapter).
- ✧ With the help of teaching aids, teacher will explain that some animals also take care of their babies.
- ✧ Now, teacher will ask students to solve 'Check Point 2'.
- ✧ At last, teacher will sum up the lesson by going through the points given under the head 'Wrap up now'.
- ✧ Teacher will help students to answer the questions given under the head 'Practice Time'.

BOOST UP

- ✧ Teacher can name some more animals other than those given in the book.
- ✧ Teacher should tell the benefits we get from domestic and pet animals.
- ✧ Teacher can add more animal babies to the list.
- ✧ Teacher should encourage students to draw and colour the picture of their favourite animal.

EXPECTED LEARNING OUTCOMES

The students understand and know

- ✧ types of animals based on their size.
- ✧ types of animals based on their living places.
- ✧ domestic and pet animals.
- ✧ the living places of wild animals.
- ✧ the names of babies of different animals.
- ✧ the parenting nature of animals.

EVALUATIVE QUESTIONS

Teacher may ask the following questions for evaluating learning and understanding of students:

1. Where do wild animals live?
2. Where do pet animals live?
3. What is a baby tiger called?
4. Where do fish and turtle live?
5. Do animals take care of their babies?
